The history of the Tottenham congregation stretches back thirty years. In 1961 members of the Edmonton SDA church, living in the Tottenham area, having distributed tracts and sold copies of Our Times and Good Health journals, began conducting Bible studies. As a consequence, in 1964, the fast growth in membership in the Tottenham area necessitated the founding of a church. Accommodation was found in the Trades Hall building

On 2 January 1965 this group was organized from a company nto a church. The service was conducted by SEC president Pastor J. H. Bayliss, assisted by Pastor John Shaw and church elder Rogers.

The growing congregation soon found the Trades Hall building too cramped. For a time worship took place at Somerset School, Lordship Lane, N17. While this building was a considerable improvement there were many occasions when it was necessary to find alternative accommodation at short notice This was why the congregation
